- A. **PURPOSE OF THE FUND:** To aid Rhode Islanders who require financial assistance in the pursuit of education within the building industry field.
- B. **WHO IS ELIGIBLE?** Any Rhode Island Resident who is unable to provide full tuition payment while pursuing courses in the building industry is eligible for this program.
- C. **TYPES OF COURSES:** Students -Courses in pursuit of an Associates, Bachelors or Certificate programs are eligible. Full or part time programs are eligible.  
Professionals-Professional Society Seminars, construction related courses to enhance current skills or to develop new skills.
- D. **AMOUNT OF AID:** Varies: maximum award \$2,500.
