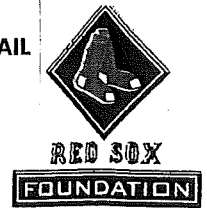

PLEASE KEEP THIS COVER SHEET and use it as a checklist to be sure you send **all** required materials. *The Red Sox Foundation will be unable to process applications found to be incomplete as of Friday, March 9, 2012. Please keep a copy of all application materials for your files.*

Applications must include all the following mailed to us in one package. Please do not send items separately.

Check list

- Completed application form. No staples please** – paper clips are fine. Please include your full name and page number on each sheet.
- One written essay** – One essay of 500 to 1,000 words (max) - Please choose just **ONE** of two essay questions on the application form. (The questions are similar to those on common college application.)
- Personal Statement** – Please include a maximum 500 word personal statement telling us something about you that we would not know otherwise from this application.
- Your Student Aid Report (“SAR”)** –The SAR is the form sent back to you after you filled out the Department of Education's Free Application for Federal Student Aid (“FAFSA”). The SAR is required for any student applying for financial aid and helps colleges determine your student loans/grants/work study package. All applicants must include a copy of the **entire** SAR, including the Expected Family Contribution (“EFC”), with your Rhode Island Red Sox Scholarships application.
- Official copies of high school transcript** – Be sure that a list of your Grade 11 and 12 courses are included on your transcript. Please also include college transcripts if you have taken any college courses for credit while in high school.
- One written recommendation from your high school guidance counselor, employer or a community service director** – NOTE: We understand teacher recommendations for college are a priority so a copy of a letter of recommendation is acceptable, however, your recommender should be aware of the academic talent and community service requirements of the Rhode Island Red Sox Scholarships. The counselor *does not need to write a special letter of recommendation* for the New Hampshire Red Sox Scholarships.
- Names of colleges you are applying to** – or have been accepted at.
- Confirmation by May 1 of the college or university you plan to attend** – If you have been accepted and already know which school you will attend, please enter it on page 2 of the application form. If you have not heard back from the college(s), you applied to please indicate that you are awaiting a decision on page 2 of the application form.

The Scholarship Committee of the Red Sox Foundation will review applications, and **decisions will be made by June 1. Applications need to be postmarked no later than Friday, March 9, 2012. Mail to:**
