



Career/Tech Application & Process
Vocational, Technical, Certificate Programs 12-24 months

Objective: To provide to two deserving graduating high school seniors who are residents of South Kingstown or Narragansett with a **One- or Two-Year Award of \$1,000.00 per year** to assist in the financial needs of further education through a 12 -24 month Vocational, Technical or Certificate Program.

GUIDELINES

1. The award is \$1,000 for one-two years. The annual award is renewable based upon a review of the recipient's academic progress (see # 9).
2. Awarded to a graduating senior from Narragansett HS, South Kingstown HS, The Prout School, or Chariho Vocational School AND is a resident of Narragansett or South Kingstown.
3. Student must be attending post high school studies at a 12 -24 month Vocational, Technical or Certificate Program.
4. The student will be of good personal character and integrity
5. The student is in need of the financial assistance provided by this scholarship
6. Community service, school involvement and classroom leadership will be considered by the committee
7. Applications will be delivered to the high schools in January and will provide a link to the information and application on the Rotary Web site where students may download the information themselves.
8. Applications are to be returned to the Guidance Department where the cover page with the name is to be removed. Each application is to be numbered. The numbers with corresponding names are to be put in a sealed envelope. A member of the scholarship committee will pick up the completed applications and the sealed envelope with corresponding names early April.
9. The Wakefield Rotary Club will notify the school which application was selected within three weeks of receipt of applications. The award is made at the senior awards banquet at the end of the school year—a member of the scholarship committee will present the award along with a certificate commemorating the award.
10. Each student will be invited to a Rotary luncheon for recognition in front of the club and will be asked to make a short speech about their activities and expectations.
11. Each student is responsible for maintaining a 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale). This requires the recipient (not the parents) to send his or her transcript and request for continuing the award at the end of each academic year. Failure to contact the chair of the Scholarship Committee will result in loss of award.
