South Kingstown Firefighter's Relief Association 2012 Scholarship Application

Eligibility

Members in good standing of Union Fire District and Kingston Fire District stations, their children, or dependents who are either (1) planning to attend a post secondary school, (2) currently attending a post-secondary school, or (3) planning to pursue a career in a vocational field. Eligible students need not necessarily be going on to further formal education, but could use the scholarship money to assist them in purchasing tools and equipment, pursuing licensing, etc. while they are actively engaged in a vocational field.

Funding

A sum of \$500.00 will be given to selected applicants upon confirmation that the recipient is furthering his or her formal education. A sum of \$500.00 will be awarded upon confirmation of employment in a vocational field if the recipient will pursue a vocational field.

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be selected on the basis of need and personal commitment to a future career. Although academic achievement will be considered, awards will not be made primarily on the basis of grades.

Attach high school or post-secondary transcript/proof of enrollment.

Attach two letters of recommendation.

Applications are due to the guidance office by April 12, 2012

Applications postmarked after April 12, 2012 will not be considered.

Applications not completed in their entirety will not be considered.
