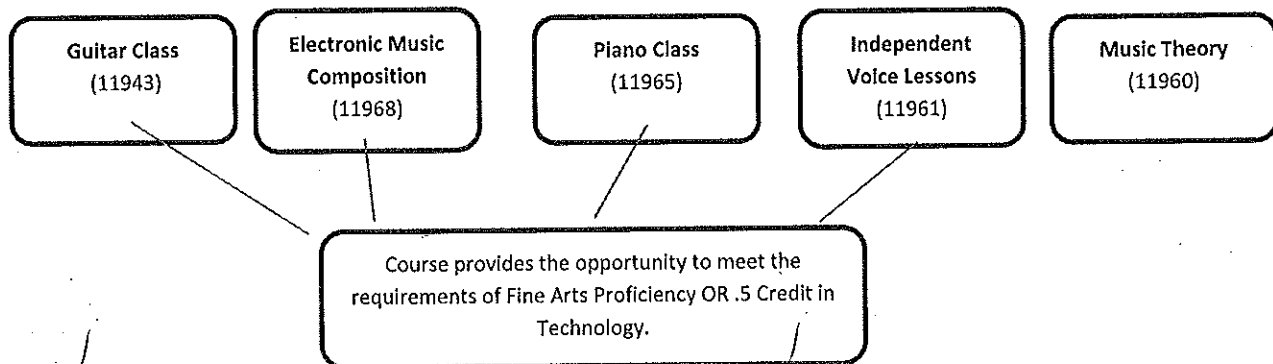
## Music Ensembles

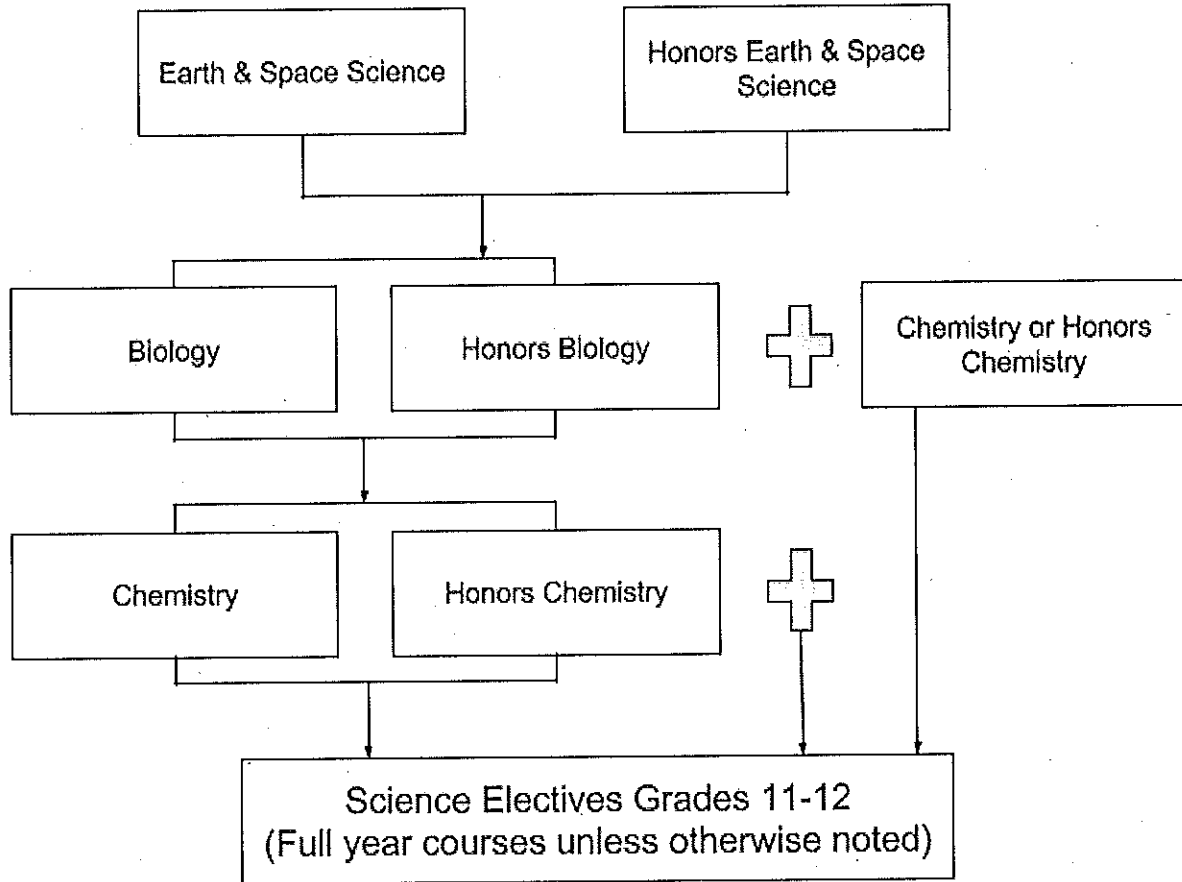


## Music Electives

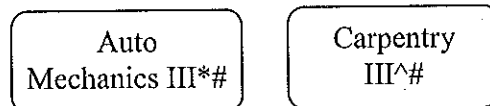

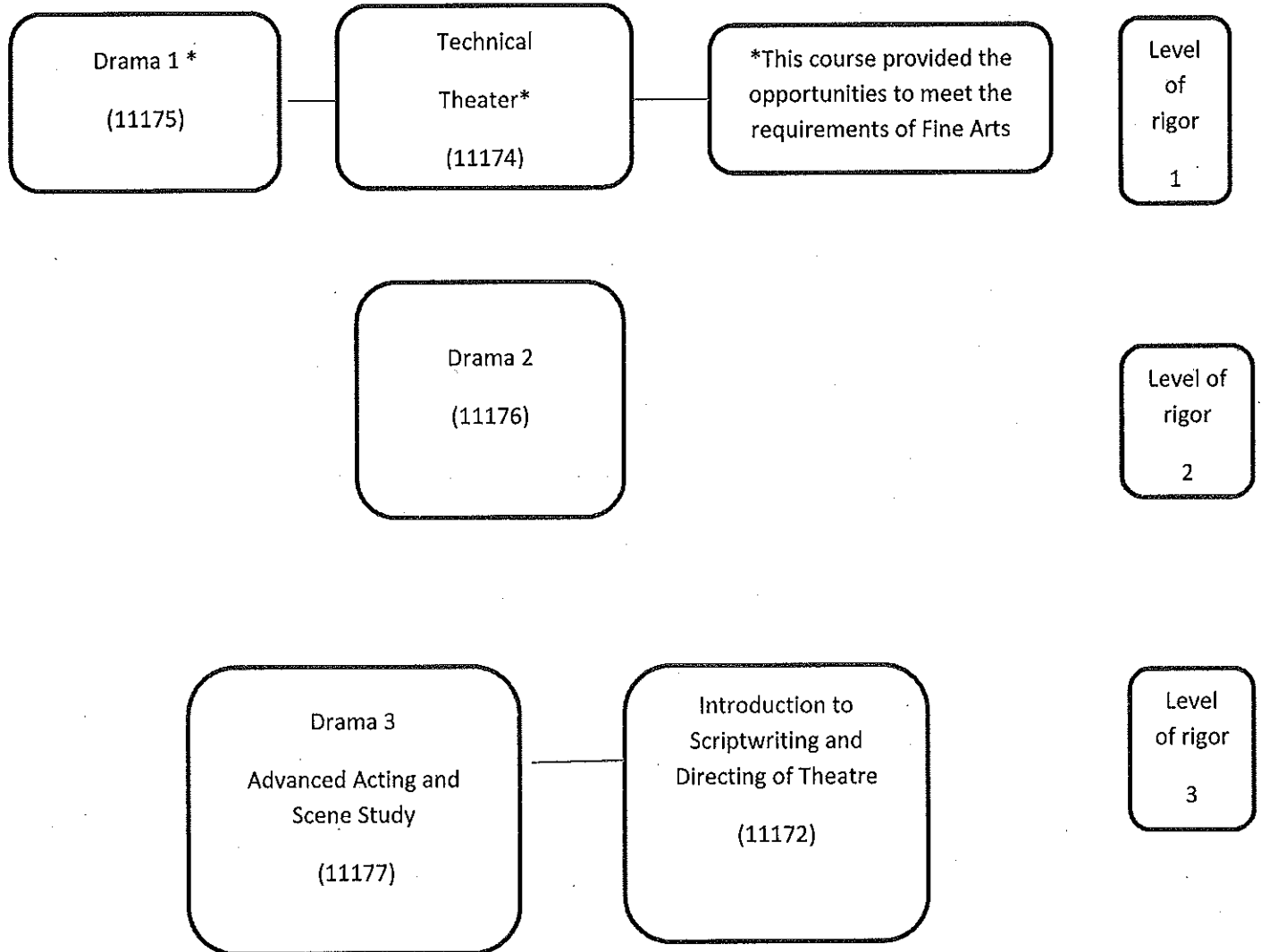
